Sigismund Stanislaus 'Stan' Pikul

Jan. 4, 1918 - Jan. 23, 2017
Former Resident of Alameda

Born Jan. 4, 1918, in Detroit, Mich., Stan died peacefully on Jan. 23, 2017, at the age of 99.

He married Mary Pauline Holt (deceased) in October 1946 in Detroit. They had eight children: Deborah Marie, Sigismund S. II, Stephen Jerome (deceased), Douglas Byron, James Thomas (deceased), Roseanne, Patrick Lee and Mary Jeffery; 10 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Stan enlisted in the U.S. Navy in May 1941. He was a member of Class 48 at Naval Boot Camp at Great Lakes.

He was stationed in Iceland in 1942 and received a Presidential Unit Citation with Anti-Submarine Patrol Squadron 84 for "Extraordinary heroism in action against enemy forces in Atlantic waters from Nov. 1, 1942, to June 30, 1943. Operating PBV Amphibious Aircraft over North



Atlantic and Arctic waters off Iceland, Patrol Squadron 84 ...succeeded in sinking six enemy German submarines..." He was later stationed at Dunkswell, Devonshire, England, as an Aviation Mechanic working on anti-submarine PBY Catalinas. In 1955 and 1956, he flew anti-submarine patrols out of Kodiak, Alaska, with P2V Anti-Submarine Patrol Squadron.

In 1962, he retired at Alameda Naval Air Station, with the rank of ADJ-1 (Jet Mechanic, First Class) after 21 and a half years of service.

From 1962 to 1982, he worked for the United States Postal Service deliv-

ering mail in Alameda. He retired and lived in Alameda until August 2013, then moved to a senior assisted-living facility in Folsom, Calif.

A funeral mass will be held on Thursday, Feb. 2, at 10:30 a.m. at St. Barnabas Church, 1427 Sixth St., Alameda.
