NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that during the Alameda City Council meeting on Tuesday, April 19, 2022, commencing at 7:00 p.m. the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider the following:

INTENT TO FORM CITY OF ALAMEDA COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO 22-1 (ALAMEDA MARINA)

On March 15, 2022, the City Council of the City of Alameda adopted a Resolution entitled "Declaring Its Intention to Establish a Community Facilities District and to Authorize the Levy of Special Taxes Therein - Alameda Marina" (the "Resolution of Intention"). Reference is hereby made to the Resolution of Intention on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Alameda for further particulars.

In the Resolution of Intention, the City Council declared its intention to form the City of Alameda (City) Community Facilities District No. 22-1 (Alameda Marina) to fund costs of certain improvements identified in an exhibit to the Resolution of Intention. The proposed boundaries of the community facilities district were identified, and the Resolution of Intention identified a proposed special tax to be levied on real property to be included in the community facilities district to fund costs of the public improvements and/or to pay debt service on bonds to be issued, in a principal amount not to exceed \$37,000,000, for the community facilities district to finance costs of the public improvements.

In the Resolution of Intention, the City Council provided that the levy of the special tax will be subject to a mailed ballot election by the landowner in the community facilities district. The City Council ordered the Director of Public Works of the City to prepare a report on the community facilities district, and called for a public hearing on the community facilities district.

At the hearing, the testimony of all interested persons or taxpayers for or against the establishment of the community facilities district, the extent of the community facilities district or the furnishing of specified types of public improvements and municipal services will be heard. Any person interested may file a protest in writing with the City Clerk of the City. If fifty percent or more of the registered voters, or six registered voters, whichever is more, residing in the territory proposed to be included in the community facilities district, or the owners of one-half or more of the area of land in the territory proposed to be included in the community facilities district and not exempt from the special tax file written protests against the establishment of the community facilities district and the protests are not withdrawn to reduce the value of the protests to less than a majority, the City Council of the City shall take no further action to establish the community facilities district or authorize the special taxes for a period of six months from the date of the decision of the City Council, and if the majority protests of the registered voters or the landowners are only against the furnishing of a type or types of public improvements within the community facilities district, or against levying a specified special tax, those types of public improvements, or the specified special tax, will be eliminated from the proceedings to form the community facilities district.

In the Resolution of Intention, the City Council also determined that certain territory identified on the boundary map for the proposed community facilities district as a future Annexation Area may be annexed in whole or in part from time to time to the community facilities district in the future, with the unanimous approval of the owner or owners of all or any portion of the property in the future Annexation Area to be annexed. The public hearing required by the City's Municipal Code relative to the future Annexation Area will be combined with the public hearing described above. At the public hearing, the testimony of all interested persons for or against the future annexation of territory to the community facilities district or the levying of special taxes within the territory proposed to be annexed in the future will be heard.

Any person interested in these matters is invited to participate at the public hearing and provide testimony, either for or against the above item. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council of the City at or prior to the public hearing.

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, this City Council adopted a Resolution entitled "Authorizing the Commencement of Proceedings for the Formation of a Community Facilities District, Designating Consultants, Approving a Deposit/Reimbursement Agreement and Authorizing and Directing Certain Related Actions With Respect Thereto - Alameda Marina," which Resolution authorized the commencement of proceedings for the formation of a community facilities district under the Law and approved a Deposit/Reimbursement Agreement between the City of Alameda (City) and Alameda Marina, LLC (the "Developer") related thereto; and

WHEREAS, City staff and consultants have been working with the Developer to determine various aspects of the proposed community facilities district, as necessary to the commencement of proceedings to form the community facilities district; and

WHEREAS, under the Law, this City Council is the legislative body for the proposed community facilities district and is empowered with the authority to establish the community facilities district and levy special taxes on property located within the community facilities district; and

WHEREAS, Arroyo Cap II-5, a Delaware limited liability company, the sole owner of the property proposed to be initially included within the boundaries of the proposed community facilities district, has submitted to the City a Petition (including Waivers) (the "Petition") requesting that the City Council form a community facilities district; and

WHEREAS, this City Council now desires to proceed with the actions necessary to consider the establishment of the community facilities district to finance certain seawall, roadway and related improvements incident to the development of the Alameda Marina area as contemplated by the Alameda Marina Master Plan, approved by the City Council in July of 2018, as well as costs of formation of a related community facilities district being formed by the City for maintenance and adaptive measures related to shoreline and seawall improvements authorized to be financed by the community facilities district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alameda that:

1. This City Council proposes to begin the proceedings necessary to establish the community facilities district (the "District") pursuant to the Law. Receipt of the Petition to form the District is hereby acknowledged.

In furtherance of the formation of the District, it is also acknowledged that the City and the Developer are parties to a Deposit/Reimbursement Agreement, pursuant to which the Developer has deposited funds with City to pay the costs of conducting the proceedings to establish the District and the possible issuance by the City of bonds for the District, subject to reimbursement from the proceeds of bonds when and if issued for the District, all as more specifically provided in the Deposit/Reimbursement Agreement.

2. The name proposed for the District is City of Alameda Community Facilities District No. 22-1 (Alameda Marina).

3. The proposed boundaries of the District are as shown on the map of the District on file with the City Clerk, which boundaries are hereby preliminarily approved. The City Clerk is hereby directed to record, or cause to be recorded, the map of the boundaries of the District in the office of the Alameda County Recorder not later than 15 days after the date of adoption of this Resolution.

4. The types of facilities (the "Facilities") proposed to be eligible for funding by the District and pursuant to the Law shall consist of those facilities described in Exhibit A hereto, which Exhibit is by this reference incorporated herein.

5. Except to the extent that funds are otherwise available to the District to pay costs of the Facilities and to pay the principal and interest as it becomes due on bonds issued by the City for the District to pay costs of the Facilities, a special tax sufficient to pay the costs thereof, secured by recodation of a continuing lien against all non-exempt real property in the District, will be levied annually within the area of the District and collected in the same manner as ordinary ad valorem property taxes or in such other manner as this City Council or its designee shall determine, including direct billing of the affected property owners. The proposed rate and method of apportionment of the special tax among the parcels of real property within the area of the District, in sufficient detail to allow each landowner or resident within the proposed District to estimate the maximum amount such owner or resident will have to pay is described in Exhibit B attached hereto which Exhibit is by this reference incorporated herein.

6. It is the intention of this City Council, acting as the legislative body for the District, to cause bonds of the City to be issued for the District pursuant to the Law to
