Anna Andersen, 93, died July 13, 2017, in Alameda. She was born on her parents' farm on Dec. 28, 1923, in Allested, Denmark.

The third of seven children born to Richard and Petra Andersen, Anna's working life outside the family farm began at the age of 14 and continued until she retired at the age of 74.

On her way to work on April 9, 1940, Anna witnessed the Nazi

Anna then made her way to Salinas, Calif., where her cousin Laura and husband Ole had agreed to sponsor her, but she quickly grew tired of small-town farm life. She visited Denmark every other year after she retired from full time work and went to other exotic destinations the alternating years. She loved Mexican music and travelled to Mexico several times, as well as Tahiti, Venice and Bali.

Anna's love of music and dance had been inspired by her father who was a musician in addition to his work on the farm. She would go to all the free concerts she could, such as Stern Grove and the Symphony in Golden Gate Park, and she could still dance with her walker at age 93. She belonged to the Sierra Club and especially loved hiking amid the majesty of Yosemite and Lake Tahoe. She never stopped walking
