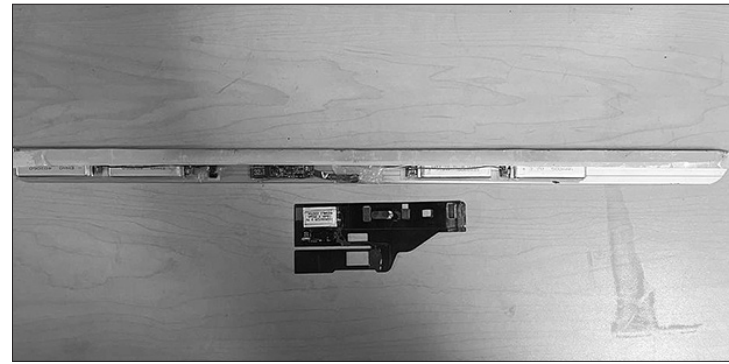
The Alameda Police Department (APD) has partnered with Hyundai Motor America and Kia America to provide free steering wheel locks to owners of Hyundai and Kia vehicles without an engine immobilizer (key-start-only cars). The program is part of APD's effort to prevent car thefts.

Free steering wheel locks are available at the Alameda Police Department located at 1555 Oak St. Supplies are limited and will be given out on a first-come, first-served basis.

To help further support the security of these vehicles, Hyundai has released a glass-break sensor security kit and is currently developing software updates to enhance vehicle security. To inquire about your vehicle's immobilizer, contact your local Hyundai or Kia dealership.

Skimmer Discovered on South Shore ATM

On Nov. 20, an automatic teller machine (ATM) service technician located a skimmer device and a pinhole camera at the South Shore Center Bank of America. The technician informed officers the machines were inspected on Nov. 18th and the devices were not present. Alameda police officers are working with Bank of America to review security footage to identify the person(s) who installed these devices.

The Alameda Police Department (APD) encourages the community to review their banking statements. If you believe your account was compromised, contact your banking institution, and file a report by visiting www.alamedaca.gov/

Skimmer devices can be hard to detect. APD says the safest alternative is to arrange for transactions to be made in person.

APD offered additional safety tips when using an ATM. "Never use an ATM that appears damaged or altered. Always cover the keypad with your hand when you enter your PIN. EDD cards typically do not have an Europay, Mastercard, and Visa (EMV) security chip, making it easier for the devices to obtain account information embedded on the magnetic strip. If using an EDD card, consider transferring EDD funds into an account with an EMV-chipped card," wrote APD in a press release.
