In early November, WETA's maintenance facility contractor conducted 10 days of around-the-clock dredging. The seals using the new float appeared unfazed by the nearby commotion, providing a note of optimism that the seals will stay when ferry traffic commences.

Seal monitor Haderlie Baker is also an artist and painter whose work includes Alameda scenes. A member of the Sierra Club, Marine Mammal Center and the Nature Conservancy, she acquired her love of nature from her late father, Eugene C. Haderlie. He was a renowned marine biologist and educator who served on the first board of trustees for the Monterey Bay Aquarium. "He would have been so pleased to know about our harbor seals," said Haderlie Baker.

company purchased woodworking machinery from businesses on the East Coast.

Barnes & Tibbitts also acquired machinery from another business that Tibbitts had an interest in: the Pacific Shipyards, once located on the site of today's Bay Ship & Yacht.

Barnes & Tibbitts stayed in business for six years. Historian Tim Colton writes that Tibbitts bought out the Barnes family in 1922 and changed the company's name to General Engineering & Dry Dock Company. By 1928, General Engineering owned the Hanlon Dry Dock shipyard at the foot of Fifth Avenue in Oakland. The company operated Hanlon as a repair yard.

General Engineering built Golden Gate ferries for the Southern Pacific Railroad and gunboats for the Coast Guard. In addition General Engineering & Dry Dock built Aloe-class net-laying ships, Auk-class minesweepers and Admirable-class minesweepers for the Navy.

In 1946 General Engineering sold the land to the Loyola University Foundation for \$7.5 million, but remained in operation there until the end of 1947. About that time, the Navy purchased 12.5 acres of the prop-

erty from Loyola, comprising the shoreline between Grand and Willow streets.

In 1952 George and Thomas Plant leased the yard from the Navy and used it as a dry dock and for ship repair. Two years later Moore Drydock moved in and built ferry boats for the Coronado-San Diego, Calif., run.

In 1959 the Navy declared the yard surplus property. By then, the City of Alameda owned 12 acres of adjacent real estate. When the Navy left, the City became the owner of 20 additional acres. Three years later, Pacific Shipyards, Inc., leased the property from the city and sowed the seeds for the Alameda Marina.

In 1966, the City of Alameda reclaimed the western edge of the old shipyard. Alameda Municipal Power's headquarters occupy this site today. That same year Svend Svendsen moved his business onto the property.

In 2012, the City renewed Pacific Shipyards' lease for 25 more years. Pacific Shipyards has announced its intention to develop the site.

City Ushers in Route 19

Sun Staff Reports Local officials including City of Alameda Mayor Trish Spencer celebrated new Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District (AC Transit) Bus Service.

The launch of bus Line 19 — a new bus route operating between Fruitvale BART and Downtown Oakland via Alameda's Buena Vista Avenue — took place on Dec. 18 last year.

The new service represents the second phase of AC Transit's expansion of service funded via Measure BB. Some \$30 million in annual tax revenues will fund a nearly 14 percent increase in overall bus service. Line 19 operates from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m., seven days a week, with 20-minute frequency during peak periods. To view the new Line 19 map and schedule, visit www.actransit.org.

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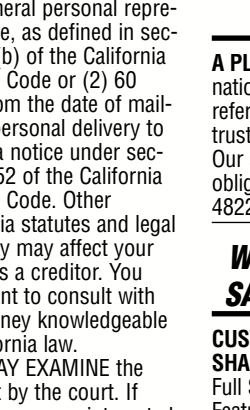
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
