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water system; and help unserved and underserved individuals and households by enhancing broadband networks owned, operated, or affiliated with local governments, non-profits, and co-ops.

Cities do not have to follow the APRA guideline precisely. However, the government laid out causes the funds cannot be used for. APRA funds cannot offset tax cuts; fund pension or rainy-day funds; fund debt service, legal settlements or matching funds; or be used for general infrastructure spending except for water systems

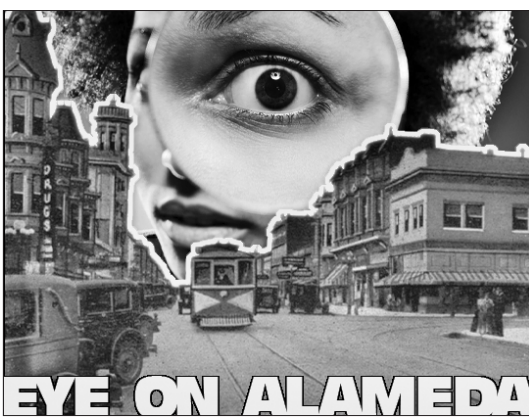
or broadband. In the meeting memorandum, staff recommends the Council consider using the five priority policy areas that were re-affirmed in 2020 as an outline for how to allocate the funds. The five policy areas include preparing Alameda for the future (climate change/infrastructure improvements); economic development; supporting enhanced livability (addressing housing and homelessness); protecting core service; and ensuring effective and effective operations.

Other staff alternative outlines include specific needs or priority project-

based frameworks. Council can recommend other frameworks for the proposal. Once a preferred framework is selected, staff will present project options through the budget process.

The city will receive half the funds (\$14 million) at the beginning of fiscal year (FY) 2020-21 on July 1. The city will receive the second half on July 1, 2022. The plan for how the funds will be spent must be finalized by the end of 2024. The funds must be spent by the end of 2026.

The deadline for public comments for the proposed dispersal of APRA funds is July 16.

A registrant who declares as true information, which he or she knows to be false is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
