Crisostomo Corpuz

Jan. 27, 1920 - Dec. 11, 2017

Crisostomo Corpuz, aka Cris, was born on Jan. 27, 1920, in Laoag City, Ilocos Norte, Philippines. He was one of four children born to Baldomero and Valentina Corpuz.



Cris was raised in the Philippines and attended the University of the Philippines as a medical student until the Japanese invaded the islands in World War II. When the school was destroyed, Cris joined the Philippine Resistance Forces to combat the Japanese and serve his countrymen. In 1946, Cris joined the U.S. Navy and came to the United States.

From America, he supported his family back in the Philippines and sent for his high school

sweetheart, Isabel Acoba, who came to Los Angeles and married Cris in 1949.

When the Korean War broke out, Cris served aboard the battleships U.S.S. New Jersey and U.S.S. Missouri. His military service took him to Norfolk, Va.; Seattle, Honolulu and Alameda, where he decided to live and retire.

In his retirement, Cris went back to school and was valedictorian of his graduating class at College of Alameda. He then went on to University of San Francisco to acquire his Bachelor of Science in sociology.

Always busy, he then worked in Real Estate for Gallagher and

Lindsay for two years. As he worked around Alameda, Cris saw many opportunities to help the community. These inspired him to form United Philipinos of Alameda (UPA) to help provide summer jobs for youths, job training for adults, lunch programs for school children and housing for low-income families.

He later founded FACSA, the Filipino-American Community Services Agency, which concentrated on supporting the Alameda Homeless Shelter and providing housing for low-income families. For his service in the community, Cris was named the Alameda Times Star's Man of the Year in 1992.

When he wasn't working, Cris made time for his hobbies,

particularly fishing and gardening. He loved the land and cultivated wonderful gardens both in Alameda and at his ranch in Copperopolis, Calif., where he also raised goats.

Cris is survived by his wife of 68 years, Isabel, and his three children: Elizabeth (Thomas), his namesake Chris and Greg (Josephine). He also is loved and remembered by his many nieces, nephews, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

A service will be held in remembrance of Cris this Saturday, Dec. 30, from 10 to 11 a.m. at St. Barnabas Church, 1427 Sixth St., in Alameda. Reception to follow. The family invites all who knew Cris to join the service and honor his memory.

Stephens of Oakland and Matthew Stephens of Las Vegas, he always wanted to make sure that he "did right" by his boys.

He is survived by his mother Carroll Stephens and sister Katherine Kaldis, both of Alameda, and his brother David Stephens of Navarre Beach, Fla., as well as grandchildren, countless aunts and cousins. His father, LeRoy Stephens of Oakland, prede-



ceased him.
