NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 24, 2018, a public hearing as required by Section 147(i) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 will be held with respect to the proposed issuance by the California Municipal Finance Authority (the "Authority") of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$45,000,000, including but not limited to revenue bonds issued as part of a plan to finance the facilities described herein (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to: (1) finance the acquisition, construction, improvement and equipping of a 70-unit multifamily rental housing facility for lower income households to be located on an approximately one-acre parcel on the east side of Orion Street commencing approximately 153 feet north of West Atlantic Avenue in the City of Alameda (the "City"), California; and (2) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The facilities are to be owned and operated by Eden Housing Inc., a nonprofit public benefit Borrower and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or a limited partnership to be established by Eden Housing Inc. or an affiliate thereof (collectively, the "Borrower").
The Bonds, and the obligation to pay principal thereof and interest thereon and any redemption premium with respect thereto, do not constitute indebtedness or an obligation of the City, the Authority, the State of California or any political subdivision thereof, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation, or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of any of them. The Bonds shall be a limited obligation of the Authority, payable solely from certain revenues duly pledged therefor and generally representing amounts paid by the Borrower.
The hearing will commence at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held in the City Hall Council Chambers, Alameda City Hall, 2263 Santa Clara Avenue, Third Floor, Alameda, California 94501. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the facilities proposed to be financed may attend the public hearing or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments.
