John Wesley King, 78, passed away Sept. 1, 2017, at his home in Portland, Ore., with family present and under the care of hospice.

John grew up in Alameda, son of Omer and Della King. He attended Alameda High School, where he ran track, played on the Northern California championship football team, served as junior class president, was chosen best-looking boy and made many lifelong friends.

John received his undergraduate degree from Fresno State in 1965, where he competed in track

and field, placing eighth in the Amateur Athletic Union men's national pentathlon.

During his undergraduate years he also spent a semester in Vienna, Austria, with the Institute of European Studies (IES), which was a life-changing experience. He enhanced his life-long interest in art, developed a new love of classical music and expanded his world view.

Upon returning to Fresno he added a major in art for his Bachelor of Arts. After graduation he obtained a Masters of Fine Arts



from Chico State and returned to Vienna in 1972, where he taught art in the IES Program.

Throughout the rest of his life he pursued a variety of jobs that were art-related, including teaching at the college level and working in galleries, auction houses and antique stores.

In 1993 he enrolled in a student program in Cambridge, England, which allowed him access to research prints in the archives of major museums. He was an avid collector, especially of antique European prints and Asian pottery.

In 1992 in Carmel, Calif., he married Susan Cato, who had two grown children. He and

Susan moved to Portland in 1995, where John joined the board of the Graphic Arts Council at the Portland Art Museum and served as an officer.

After being introduced to the Portland Masters Track Club, John took up discus and javelin throwing with a passion and won awards all over the West, making many close friends. He served as an officer and board member of the club and was given the Most Inspirational Award.

John always lived life his way in pursuit of his two great passions: art and sports and, in the end, said that life was good. He cherished his friendships old and new and had a soft spot for animals. John was

predeceased by his parents and his brother Omer King. He is survived by his wife, his children by marriage, Joe Kazzoun (Claudette) of Austin and Alia Shirley (Kurt) of Portland, three grandchildren, Anna and Aidan Shirley and Esme Kazzoun, sister-in-law Claudia and

nieces Kristi Morano and Karen Richardson of California.
