**Alameda Island Brewing Company:** AIBC is all about making great beer in a great town. You are sure to find an instant favorite among one of the many beers that are reminiscent of the island's culture and history, such as Neptune's Pale Ale, Cavanaugh Kolsch, Park Street Morning Porter and Otis IPA. AIBC has created a beautiful and welcoming space for families (kids are welcome) and even dogs. The brewery, tasting room, and patio are located right here in Downtown Alameda at 1716 Park Street. **Rock Wall Wines:** The Rock Wall Wine Company is a boutique winery that produces award-winning wines from multiple California growing regions offering different grape varieties,

### Find the Public Restrooms

For the convenience of our festival-goers, you'll find portapotties located at four easy-to-find locations:

- Alameda Avenue, near the Kids' Area
- Bank of Marin, in the alleyway between Central and Santa Clara avenues
- Times Way, near the Main Library

• Buena Vista Avenue and Park Street, across from the Marketplace

### Find Parking or Take the Bus

Leave the car behind! AC Transit will be operating Lines 20, 21, 51A and O throughout the weekend. Plan your trip to and from Park Street by using the TripPlanner tool on [www.511.org](http://www.511.org).

Ride your bike to the Faire! There couldn't be a better way to experience the festival than after a pleasant ride along the charming streets of Alameda. Free, secure bike parking will be available at the corner of Park Street and Webb Avenue, near Alameda Bicycle (1522 Park St.)

If you must drive — the Civic Center Parking Garage is conveniently located on Oak Street just around the corner from the Alameda Theatre & Cineplex. Street parking in the surrounding neighborhoods is also available. Although parking is free on Sunday, time limits are in effect both days.
